

GT-Content Book Study Procedures

The following expectations need to be met in order to satisfy training requirements:

- The facilitator must submit a completed GT 6-HR Update Form to the District GT Coordinator for approval prior to the book study being starting.
- The book study must focus on meeting the nature and unique needs of gifted and talented students.
- It must include participation in a collaborative environment of multiple online or faceto-face meetings for analysis and discussion of content.
- Professional Development and GT credit hours will be issued ON LY for participants who
 read, analyze, and discuss the GT content of the approved book. A completed PD Survey
 must be completed before credit will issued.
- Participants will receive 3 hours for reading the book and up to an additional 3 hours for meetings, discussions, and activities.
- STUDY and DISCUSSION QUESTIONS MUST BE ATTACED TO THE GT 6-HR UPDATE PD FORM.
- Facilitators of the GT Book Study must have completed 30 hours of GT training as required by TEA plus be current with their annual update hours.
- Facilitators must state the <u>specific</u> GT-content focus of the training in the description section (*Topic of Study & Activities*) of the Gt 6-HR Update PD Form.
- The District GT Coordinator will set up the course in Eduphoria for teachers to register and award teachers credit upon completion of the requirements.
- BOOK STUDIES ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR FOUNDATIONAL TRAINING CREDIT.
